



Charles Robert Joseph Lacerte

October 20, 1959 - January 28, 2024

It is with great sadness that we announce the passing of Charles Robert Joseph Lacerte of Eastern Passage, Nova Scotia, on the evening of January 28, 2024. Charles passed away peacefully in the QEII Hospital after a cardiac incident at the age of 64.

Born in St. Boniface, Manitoba on October 20, 1959, Charles was one of four children of Aline (1929-2018) and Bruno Lacerte (1931-1986). When Charles was a child, his family moved from Winnipeg to Montreal, eventually settling in Calgary. In the 1980s Charles made a weekend trip

to visit his sister in Nova Scotia and it is where he has called home ever since.

Charles' love of food and cooking lead him to a career in the culinary industry where he trained in the culinary program at the Southern Alberta Institute of Technology. He went on to gain experience in various restaurants prior to working in Nova Scotia at the Lord Nelson, Scanway, McKelvies, and finally Trendz before retiring in 2021.

Charles was happiest when he was spending time with his grandchildren, Zoe

and Andrew, golfing, and travelling. Charles' love of travel led him and his loving wife Stephanie to different countries all over the world where they enjoyed trying new foods and "living as the locals do" wherever they went.

Charles is survived by his wife Stephanie Lacerte, his children Janis (Jeff Mader) and Gary (Amber LaRocke). He is also survived by his siblings Lucille (Larry Graham), Joanne (Brian Myck), Paul (Adette Radford); Nieces and nephews Jennifer (Jay) Sproule, Jaimie (Darcy) Myck, Kathleen (Derek) Graham, and Christine (Kristof) Serdynski; and other family members to whom Charles was dearly beloved.

A memorial service and reception will be held Friday, February 9th, 2pm at Christ Church, 61 Dundas St., Dartmouth.
