It is with profound sadness that we announce the passing of Dallas Curtiss Borden (January 2 1957 – August 27 2024) (67).

Over the last two months Dallas showed courage, strength and grace while battling health complications in hospital.

He never lost his faith or sense of humor.

Dallas was surrounded by his family who loved him dearly, and his furry companion Audi while listening to his favorite music, when he passed away peacefully.

He is survived by his mother, Dorothy Summers (Donald), siblings, Wilford (Lynn) Borden (Barb Gaul), Wayne (Kip) Borden, Denise Borden (Brian Strong), and children Tara Borden (Shawn Darling), Curtiss Borden (Megan Wallace, James Leong) and Emmitt Borden (Kelsey Bennett) and grandchildren Jackson and Henry Darling (Tara & Shawn).
