It is with heavy hearts we announce the passing of Lee Patrick Maxwell on April 18, 2024. Born in Truro on September 1, 1967, he was the son of the late Earl F. Maxwell and Ruth (Carr) Maxwell. The family moved to Fairview a month later. He went to school in Fairview, graduated from Halifax West with a close group of friends, and went on to graduate from Saint Mary's University with Bachelor of Arts and Bachelor of Commerce degrees.

After graduating from Saint Mary's University, he started a family business and was later joined by his siblings. We were very fortunate to spend many years working with Lee.

Lee took up the game of golf in High School and loved spending many hours smashing the ball around in those early years with his good buddies. Years later he spent many Septembers playing in the BVD Annual Golf Tournament and created many fond memories during this time with his fellow "Duffers". Not known as a frequent runner, he ran in the inaugural Bluenose Half Marathon and completed the Full Marathon in each of the following three years.

Lee is survived by a family that loved him dearly: brother Ralph (Roselle d'Entremont) Nephew Léo Jacquard); Sister Joyce Roberts (Bruce); Nephew Scott Roberts; Niece Brianne Roberts, and several cousins.

Cremation has taken place. There will be a celebration of life at a later date.
