What can I say about My Mom, Our Mom.... first and foremost, she loved her family, her mom and dad, brothers and sisters, and the five of us. We all grew up in the same home she did... sometimes up to 20 of in that small little home on Lynch St. We all seemed to thrive in that home. As a girl in the Northend, she went to St Stephens School, and went to the same church. She loved that place and never wanted to leave. She lived there from 1950s until 2020. Our

grandparents, our aunts and uncle, sometimes four to a tiny room, lived in that tiny home on Lynch St. On cold winter mornings standing over the heating grate and waiting for whoever was in the bathroom to finish, one toilet, one sink and a bathtub. Sunday night bath nights were a real event. Most of us never experienced a shower until we left home. Mom's most amazing ability was to be able to continuously smoke and never slow down. She only finally quit at age 82. She loved her word puzzles, lexicons, and she was famous for having us go through the Timmy's drive thrus, and order here medium coffee, 2 cream and 6 sugars, yup you heard it here, 6 sugars. So many good times. When they bought the cottage in New Russel, in 1995 it started a whole new adventure for her, Dad and our family. Those were the best years.

When we lost our dad in 2018, she lost the love of her life. She was truly lost without him. Those two were amazing, one minute arguing, the next minute jiving to a 50s tune on the radio. They were jiving right up until end, and man they could dance. Amazing to watch them. He loved her dearly, always worrying about what would happen when he was gone. They were both hardcore Northenders, there was no way she would ever leave it. That neighbourhood defined all who lived there. She was the last of the originals on Glebe and Lynch. Sadly, dementia reared its ugly head and stole our mother from us. Rest in Peace Mom, we shall all miss you very much.

Cremation has taken place. A private graveside service will be held later in the year at the Gate of Heaven Cemetery in Lower Sackville.
