It is with heavy hearts that we announce the passing of Mary Margaret Ronaldson on Sunday 05 October 2025 at the tender age of 97. Known to family and friends as Marg , she was born in Hull, Yorkshire England on 18 June 1928, to Sydney and Barbara Taylor (Scotland) where she remained until being evacuated to Burntisland, Fife Scotland at the start of WWII.

Having met the man of her dreams in Scotland Marg was married to David Arnott Ronaldson on 17 March 1951 and came to Canada in 1956 where they began a new life and adventure together in Baker Lake, Nunavut. This was followed by 4 year stays in Winnipeg and Brandon, Manitoba, Saskatoon, Saskatchewan, and Dorchester, Ontario. They retired to Goderich, Ontario where they spent 20 wonderful years golfing and enjoying the life of snowbirds. A gifted singer, Margaret was involved in many choirs over the years and thoroughly enjoyed performing at festivals, community events and senior homes in Florida. An avid golfer in her younger years Marg had what many called a unique golf swing which earned her the nickname Mrs. Jonathon Daley.

Following the passing of her husband of 55 years, Marg made her final move to Halifax, Nova Scotia in August 2006 where she quickly became involved in the Ladies Dart League and many other events at the Chiefs and PO's Mess at CFB Halifax. A huge fan of bingo, Marg was a big supporter of TV bingo

and planned her weekly schedule around it and the Saturday bingo at the RCNA Club. Marg enjoyed her final years at The Berkeley in Bedford where she met some dear friends and was well cared for by the kind and wonderful staff.

Margaret is pre-deceased by her husband, David, and oldest son, David Jr. She is survived by her sons Ian (Nancy), Scott (Wendy); grandchildren Michael (Megan), Andrew (Emily), Jillian (Josh) and DJ (Angelica); and 8 great grandchildren Makayla, Lyla, Camden, Graeme, Chloe, Rowan, Emmi and Davina.
