A former employee of St. Mary's University, was a man who beat the odds and lived fifty years beyond what medical science had predicted. Paul was pragmatic, especially when it came to death having faced and stared it down many times. A non-compliant patient who wrote his own rule book, Paul was supported throughout the years by brilliant and caring medical professionals and twice was blessed by unnamed organ donors whose gifts added years to his life.

Paul's siblings had front row seats to his struggles, marvelled at his resilience, and like all the friends he gathered along the way, took joy in the many silver linings that followed those struggles, with the greatest being his relationship

with Sally. Not only did she love him, she was also proud of him; clearly, they were made for each other.

Paul is survived by his siblings Mary (Art) Judge, David (Margo) Jeffrey, Catherine (Brad) Wilson, Leonard (Phyllis) Murray, Kathryn (Ed) Chatman, 23 nieces and nephews, numerous great nieces and nephews, and extended (Murray and Macisaac) family and friends.
