It is with heavy hearts that we announce the sudden passing of André Rocheleau on February 2, 2024. Born in Hull, Quebec, on August 23, 1959, he was the son of the late Mary (Woodworth)

and Gilbert Rocheleau and brother to Brian Rocheleau.

One of André's most memorable traits was that he was always bumping into people he knew. No

matter the place, it was guaranteed that he would eventually see a familiar face, which was

ultimately a testament to his outgoing and kind personality.

While André loved many things, he loved his girls, Lorraine, Andrea, and Katieann, more than anything else. After meeting at The Palace and spending the night talking and playing backgammon, André married the love of his life, Lorraine, on May 12, 1990. Lorraine and André spent 40 years together building a life full of laughter and a home that welcomed all friends and family.

Being a father was one of André's greatest achievements; nothing made him more proud than hearing about their accomplishments and watching them become the strong women they are today. His daughters were his pride and joy; he would do anything for them.

The way André's face lit up when he spoke about Andrea and Katieann is something that his friends and family will forever cherish. Another momentous part of André's life was becoming a grandfather. His love was endless for Jackson and Arianna, he was always eager for their summer visits to show them off to any and everyone.
