February 2, 1947 - November 2, 2022

Huggins, Robert “Bob” Allen of Halifax passed away peacefully, surrounded by family at Dartmouth General Hospital Wednesday, November 2, 2022, at the age of 75.

Bob grew up in Windsor, Nova Scotia and moved to Halifax during his teenage years. A graduate of Queen Elizabeth High School and Saint Mary’s University he had a successful 35-year career with the federal government. He began his career with Parks Canada at Cape Breton Highlands and Terra Nova National Parks. He then returned to Halifax to work for the Department of Fisheries and Oceans until he retired in 2008.

An avid camper, Bob enjoyed annual road trips and camping adventures with his sons Mike and Chris, often travelling a week or two at a time exploring different regions of Eastern Canada and the United States. In retirement, Bob remained close friends with his former colleagues from Fisheries and Oceans, enjoying social time and golfing with them. Bob spent many winters enjoying the sun and golf courses in Venice, Florida. Bob liked to stay informed on current events and was always up for conversation about news, politics, and sports.

He will be lovingly remembered by his brother Jack Huggins of Halifax and his sons Michael Huggins (Julia Murphy) of Bedford and Christopher Huggins of Halifax. He was a son of the late Blanche (Ritchie) and Robert "Bob" Huggins of Halifax and Windsor, Nova Scotia.

Cremation has taken place. As per Bob's wishes there will be no funeral, a family celebration of life will take place at a later date.
