THOMAS GERARD GERRIOR, age 69 died, peacefully at Hospice, Halifax,, NS on June 5, 2022.

When time permitted, from his very busy work schedule, he often joined in with music and fun with his brothers and sisters, all of whom come from a family musical background. Tom loved music and played guitar and sang with a very unique and enjoyable style which was very entertaining at all family gatherings.

He will be dearly missed by all his family, friends, co-workers, patients and their families .

Tom always said: " there are some wonderful people in this world" and this surely applies to all the staff and volunteers at Hospice in Halifax whom we would like to dearly thank for their superb care of Tom and for making his stay there, both enjoyable and comfortable during his fight with cancer.
