William George "Bill" Snyder, 77, of Blockhouse, NS, passed away on March 12, 2025, at South Shore Regional Hospital, with family by his side.

Bill was predeceased by his parents, George, and Nellie (Vogler) Snyder. He is survived by his sister Wendy (Robert) Underwood of Toronto, nieces Sarah (Halifax) and Amy (Toronto), great-niece Bailey (Toronto), and great-nephew Gilbert (Halifax).

Raised in Crousetown, NS, Bill's early education began in a one-room schoolhouse before attending King's-Edgehill in Windsor. He was a marine diver, and spent much of his life in the 1960's in Halifax working with Coleman Day and the Swordsman Coffee House.

Curious by nature, Bill loved how stuff worked, the challenge of fixing things, and always had a project on the go.

He was a fierce advocate for accessibility and transportation rights, and a dedicated volunteer in his community, working with many organizations through the years. He had a keen interest in history, and nature, embraced technology, and was skilled at photo restoration.

Bill's humour and fondness for facts and detail made him a teller of many the

'tall-ish' tale. He loved his mom's homemade peanut butter birthday cakes.

Like his mom, Bill was interested in environmental sustainability and was always dreaming up ways he might make a difference.

Bill's curiosity and advocacy will be missed by those who knew him.

In keeping with Bill's wishes, there will be no funeral service. A private family interment will take place at St. Mary's, Crousetown, in the summer.
